OUR MISSION BEING CARRIED OUT

This year was full of so many highs but also it came with many lows. We welcomed new children, saw some take their first steps, and we also said goodbye to some who were reunited with families. One of our biggest struggles this year was the overwhelming amount of children we received with chronic illnesses requiring a lot of hospitalization, therapy, and more care at home. We have watched them come so far but they have a long road ahead of them.

This year we **served 65 children** providing food, shelter, medical care, and education. We also **placed 7 children** back in their homes with relatives who received parenting classes and the child is still receiving free education and medical care with our assistance. We welcomed **4 newborns** this year. We sent **1** to high school. **38** of our children were enrolled in school last year. Many of them placed 1st in national exams. We **served 7,200 pounds** of rice and **4,000 pounds** of beans.

We **empowered 38 families** through paying \$20,000 total in salaries for them to provide food, shelter, clothing, medical, and education.

We also **hired a full time nurse** who cut medical cost down \$300/monthly. Also provided 416 hours of physical therapy to those in need.



